



PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

The Master of Business Information Systems (MBIS) course offered by Lincoln University College (LUC) focuses on the development of the self-reflective mindset, the analytic mindset, the collaborative mindset, the worldly mindset, and the action mindset. For successful completion of Master's degree each candidate should publish minimum of two research articles in Scopus indexed journals with Lincoln University College affiliation.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

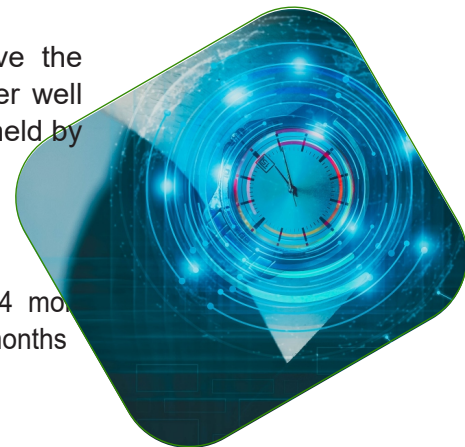

INTAKE AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Intake: March, July, October

- i. A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, Malaysian Qualifications Framework, MQF) in related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 as accepted by the Lincoln University College Senate, OR
- ii. A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 and not meeting CGPA of 2.50 can be accepted, subject to a rigorous internal assessment, OR
- iii. A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in non-related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 as accepted by the Lincoln University College Senate and with relevant working experience, subject to a rigorous internal assessment, OR
- iv. A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in non-related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 as accepted by the Lincoln University College Senate and without relevant working experience, subject to passing pre-requisite courses, OR
- v. Other equivalent related qualifications to a Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) recognized by the Malaysian Government, AND
- vi. Achieve a minimum Band 4 in Malaysian University English Test (MUET) OR equivalent to Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) (Mid 82).
